



# Safety Policy

You will be practicing actual rescue techniques used in real-life emergency response operations. There is an element of risk inherent to emergency responders due to the environment in which we work. You will wear all personal protective equipment (hard hat, safety eye wear, safety boots and follow all instructions as directed by TEAM-1 Academy Inc. staff. For your own safety you are encouraged to leave loose clothing, rings, chains, and other jewelry at home.

We reserve the right to postpone classes at any time if we have a concern for your safety due to weather conditions/forces of nature (i.e. extremely high water levels, lightning, or dangerous conditions). At the time of your course, you must be capable of performing physical activity representative of the duties specific to the course disciplines (ie. Rescue, Fire Fighting, etc.). If you show up fatigued, injured or suffering from the effects of alcohol or drugs you can expect to be dismissed (without refund) from the class at the sole discretion of the instructor.

You will be required to sign a waiver of liability at the beginning of the course that acknowledges that you understand the following information and have provided any medical information to the instructor.
